- Sterling silver clasp
- Sterling silver ear wires
- 1 packet 100 x 6mm ED sterling jump rings
- 1 packet 100 x 4mm ED sterling jump rings.

Pearly Queen Necklace *

Jo Lochhead 10am-12pm (£16)

Metallic jewels combine with sleek Swarovski pearls in this sumptuous bead-woven necklace. You'll learn the Ogalala technique – your perfect introduction to bead-weaving.

Materials required

Beads may be pearls, crystals, 4mm cubes or Czech glass.

- 1-2 packets of size 8 seed beads
- Second row: 72 x 4mm beads (we used 36 crystals and 36 pearls)
- Third row: 36 x 6mm beads and 36 8mm beads for the peaks
- 144 x 6mm or 4mm beads for either side of the peaks.
